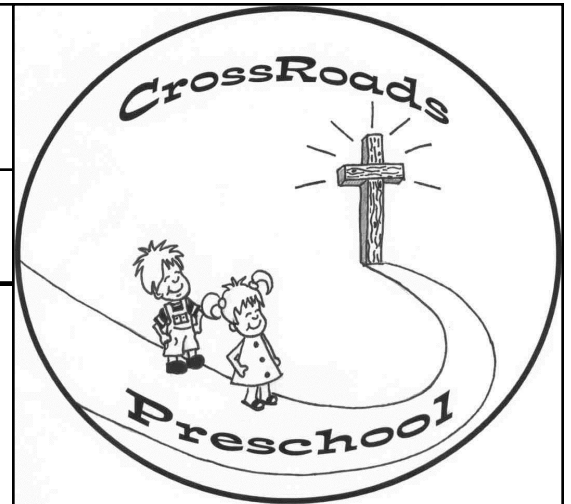

During the month of February we will be holding parent-teacher conferences. Soon there will be sign-up sheets at your sign-in tables. The conferences for the Pre-K classes will be held on Friday, Feb. 20th and Friday, Feb. 27th.

Conferences will be about 15 minutes in length. We have many parents to meet with. Teachers will be sharing your child's progress with you. Please jot down any questions you may have and save them for this time.

In order to make this a productive time we ask that your children not be present. We will have one classroom open for students to stay in during the a.m. times while you have your conference. Our assistants will supervise them.

The three year olds will be receiving assessment sheets toward the end of February/beginning of March. I would like to allow a little more time as Miss Cherrie only has two days to spend with the students and she also has over 30 of them. You will have an opportunity to look over your child's assessment form, then sign up for a conference time if you wish.
