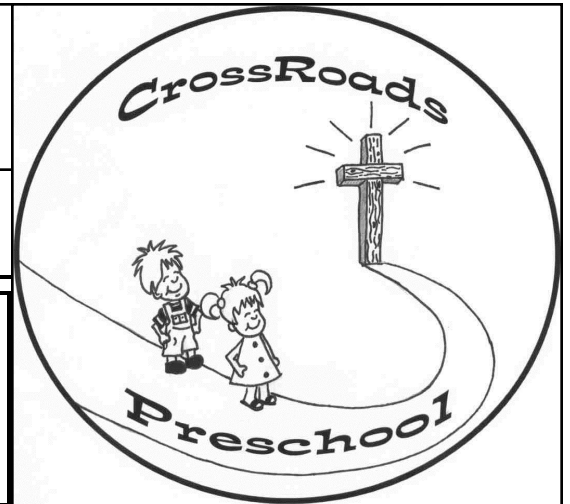

Jan. 19th—”O” week

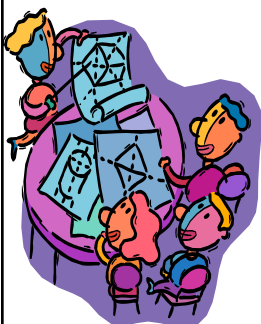
Jan. 26th—”P” week

Playtime Pointers

Some fun things you can do at home when you’re just hanging around the house.

- Practice standing on one foot
 - Hopping on one foot
- Run a piece of masking tape across the floor to create a balance beam
- Pretend the room is a creek and put out some rocks(paper plates) to hop onto. Make sure both feet are getting off the ground at the same time

All of these activities will promote the development of balance and gross motor skills. Play with your child!!
