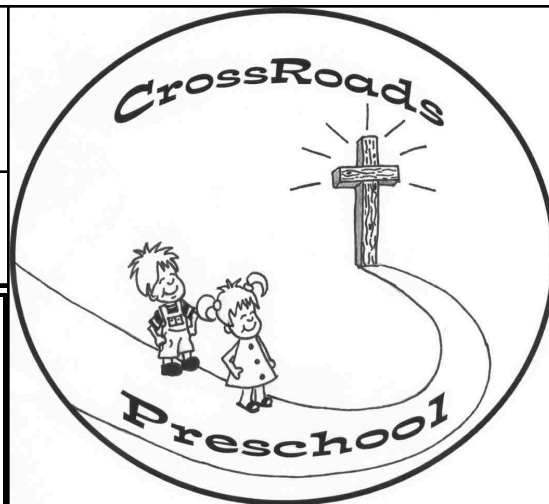

Nov. 9th — “H” week

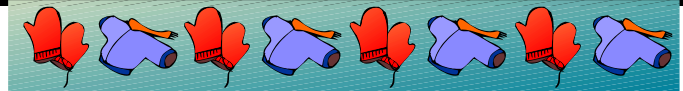
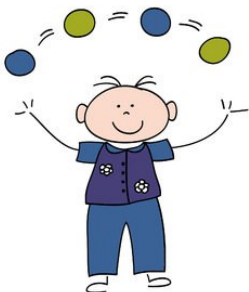
Nov. 16th — “T” week
