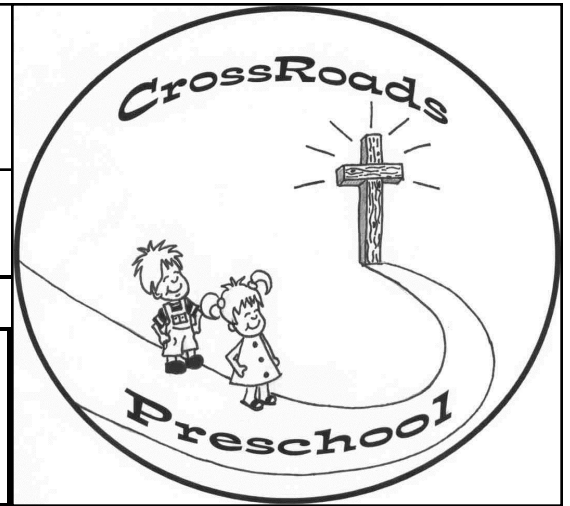

RED.

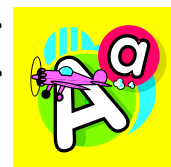
The children will learn a song about the color red. It will teach them how to spell the color. Ask your child to sing the song for you. It is sung to the tune of "Frere Jacques."
